We are dedicated to providing a safe, fun environment where young sailors can refine their racing skills or enjoy recreational sailing as an activity to do with friends. At SYC every young sailor will create memories that last a lifetime and have the opportunity to achieve their personal goals in the sport of sailing.



The SYC Junior Sailing Program provides a high level of sailing instruction and coaching for beginner, intermediate, and advanced sailors who want to take their skills to the next level. We provide an environment conducive to learning boating safety and making friends. We teach all sailors the fundamentals of sailing which include: water safety, the Corinthian spirit, sportsmanship, teamwork, seamanship, points of sail, parts of the boat, boat handling skills, parts of the sail, sail tuning, knots, and wind direction. If a sailor is interested in continuing their sailing education, SYC offers programs all year long as well. In the summer months, SYC provides one of the most sought after Summer Sailing Programs for children and teens.



FLYING SCOT PROGRAM

The Flying Scot program is geared for sailors who wish to sail alongside their friends while learning all aspects of sailing. In the FS program, there is an instructor on board at all times.

OPTIMIST HARBOR MICE & GREEN FLEET

Optimist Harbor Mice is tailored for our new sailors to learn how to sail an optimist dingy. They start off learning with a fellow camper on board, working towards sailing alone. Instructors will be at their side in both powerboats and kayaks. The Optimist is the most sailed class in the world., and a SYC favorite. This class is the doorway to a lifetime of sailing.

SUNFISH & LASER CLASS

The Sunfish and Laser class is designed for sailors who want to learn basic sailing skills at a faster pace. The class is sailed with 1 – 3 sailors on board, while instructors assist from a powerboat.

Ages 11 - 15.

RACING & TEEN PROGRAMS

OPTIMIST GREEN FLEET

A program focuses on developing better boat handling skills, learning racing tactics, and fine-tuning sail controls. fine-tune them by participating in practice races and other challenges throughout the camp session. Sailors are required to have their own boat; limited boat charters are available from SYC for an additional fee. **Ages 9-11**

SUNFISH & LASER

Sailors participating in this class will aim to learn the basics of boat handling and racing. They will put those new skills to use in challenges against their fellow classmates throughout the camp session. **Ages 11 - 15**

BEGINNER & INTERMEDIATE C420

Training that focuses on fundamentals of boat handling skills, racing & performance techniques, as well as FUN and RECREATION. This program is ideal for our teen campers, it teaches teamwork and prepares them for High School & College sailing while encouraging them to have fun! Sailing Experience not required. This class is highly recommended for teen campers. **Ages 11-15**
